COMPLAINT — GENERAL PURPOSES — MADE AND SUMMONS


THE COMPLAINT OF Geoffrey Orman of the Environmental Protection Agency in the State of Queensland, a Public Officer within the meaning of Section 142A of the *Justices Act 1886* made this 29th day of July 2003 before the undersigned, a Justice of the Peace for the said State, who says that over or at some unknown time during August 2000 and September 2001 at the Main Range National Park in the Magistrates Court District constituted by the Division of the Warwick District appointed under the *Justices Act 1886*, **Vincent Thomas BOYLE** as trustee for the Mount Colliery Cattle Trust and not being an authorised person within the meaning of section 62 of the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*, did cause to be taken (namely by clearing approximately 32.7 acres of vegetation with a D8K Caterpillar bulldozer and a D85A Kamatzsu bulldozer and then by burning the vegetation and then preventing regrowth by grazing cattle), a natural resource of a protected area (namely vegetation in the Main Range National Park), without being such act or omission not being authorised under section 62 of the *Nature Conservation Act 1992* and such act or omission occurring within a protected area and without taking reasonable precautions and exercising due diligence to avoid the act or omission,

contrary to the Acts and regulations in such case made and provided.


TAKE NOTICE that for the purposes of section 165 of the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*, the prosecution elects to proceed by way of indictment.

TAKE NOTICE that if you are convicted the complainant will seek orders rehabilitation under section 168 of the *Nature Conservation Act 1992* and \$280,000 compensation under section 168 of the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

WHEREUPON the said complainant prays that I, the said Justice, will proceed in the premises according to law.
