The applicant applies for a declaration under section 21 of the Federal Court of Australia Act 1976 and a prohibitory injunction under section 475 of the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 in relation to conduct of the respondent constituting an offence or other contravention of the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999.

A. DETAILS OF CLAIM

On the grounds stated in the accompanying Statement of Claim, the applicant claims:

- 1. A declaration that the killing, injuring, taking or interfering with any Antarctic minke whale (*Balaenoptera bonaerensis*) in the Australian Whale Sanctuary by the respondent contravenes sections 229, 229A, 229B and 229C of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999*, and that the treating or possessing by the respondent of any Antarctic minke whale killed or taken in the Australian Whale Sanctuary contravenes sections 229D and 230 of the Act, unless permitted or authorised under sections 231, 232 or 238 of the Act.
- 2. A prohibitory injunction restraining the respondent from killing, injuring taking or interfering with any Antarctic minke whale (Balaenoptera bonaerensis) in the Australian Whale Sanctuary, or treating or possessing any Antarctic minke whale killed or taken in the Australian Whale Sanctuary, unless permitted or authorised under sections 231, 232 or 238 of the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999.
