

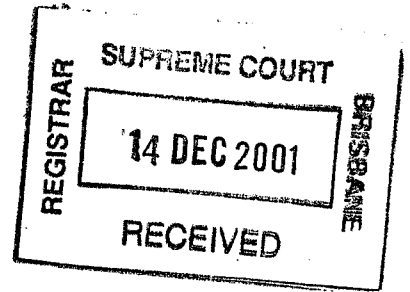

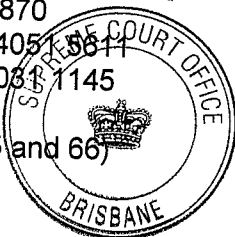

[Notice of appellant]

1. Unless special grounds are shown in Form 38 (Application for leave to adduce evidence (rule 108) and are made out, the application or appeal will be decided on the same material that was before the trial or sentencing judge.
2. If you change your address, or place of custody, or your legal representatives, you must notify the registrar in writing.
3. If this notice is not filed with the Registrar or given to the General Manager of the prison or person in charge of any other place in which the person is held in custody within 1 calendar month after the judgment appealed against, you must also complete form 28 (Notice of application for extension of time ~~w~~ within which to appeal) and attach it to this notice (rules 65 and 66)
